Grade 9 Immunization Program

As per current direction from Alberta Health the School Health Program has now been directed to focus on delivering Grade 9 immunizations, as able, while continuing to support the Covid vaccine rollout.

The following immunizations are recommended for Grade 9 students:

- A booster dose of diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis (dTap) vaccine
- A dose of meningococcal conjugate A,C,Y,w-135 (MenC-ACYW) vaccine
- Any routine childhood vaccines the student may have missed

Consent packages have been dropped off at the school for all Grade 9 students. Parents are requested to return the consents to the school indicating if they wish to proceed with immunization at school by April 19, 2021. The exact dates for immunization delivery will be announced once determined.
