## **Covid Updates**

# **COVID-19 Isolation Requirement Changes**

As we settle back into our daily routines following the Winter Break, we'd like to draw your attention to some changes to the provincial health measures that will have a direct impact on schools. These changes are summarized in the Division's updated Stay at Home Guide. Please keep your child home if they are ill so we can all do our part to keep our school community healthy, safe and so we can remain open.

As more of the general population becomes fully vaccinated, this will play a factor in how soon your child may return to school following a legally required isolation due to a positive COVID-19 test. Fully vaccinated individuals only need to isolate for 5 days or until symptoms resolve, whichever is longer. **PLUS** a new measure includes 5 days of wearing a mask at all times when around others at school. This will mean students will have to eat in an alternate location when they need to take masks off. We can work with families to help facilitate this upon a student's return to class. Those partially vaccinated or not vaccinated students remain legally required to isolate for 10 days or until symptoms resolve, whichever is longer, before returning to school. ## Rapid Tests and Medical Grade Masks

A survey was sent to all Copperhaven School families to record which families wish their child/ren to receive rapid tests and/or medical grade masks. With over 750 students in our school it will take some work to sort the tests and masks and distribute them to our students. The masks and tests were delivered to the school around 1:00 on Friday afternoon. Staff worked diligently to package and deliver to classrooms as many as we were able before students were dismissed. Grade 8 and 9 students along with our kindergarten classes who were not in attendance at school on Friday will receive their materials on Monday. If you have not yet completed the survey or completed it late on Friday your child's materials will be distributed as we gather the survey data. If students are absent, materials will be held by the homeroom teacher for distribution upon the child's return.
