Getting help when needed To access resources or be able to fill out forms as required





Google classroom is not used to its potential, kids are not clearly taught how to use it.

Teachers seem to be struggling to keep up with it, with all the extra work they have had to do.



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Lack of textbooks being used has created issues, especially if you don't have a printer to **print everything off.** When ensuring that your child is able to complete all of the required reading, assignments, and homework, most of their day ends up being on screens

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Ice on the school grounds is dangerous and not acceptable. There is nothing for middle school kids to do in the winter = slide or throw **snowballs.** Students are permitted to slide and play on the ice, including sliding down hills. Have heard numerous stories of injuries.
